Counseling People with Anger and Aggression

Last month, I shared about boundaries. This month, I will address how I deal with the anger we have when our boundaries are crossed. Anger is often the immediate reaction within us. We conquer this by recognizing who we are in Christ.

We all are addicted to some particular sin and no matter what the sin or habit, we are weak and helpless to change by will power alone. The first thing all must understand is our own values. These values define who we are. As counselors, we must consistently keep these in mind as we counsel. I, personally, have a list of values I give to my client. This value sheet helps me when the client goes outside his own value system and thereby sins. This is the opportunity to remind the client who he is in Christ as he often feels like a total failure in God's eyes.

There is a clear struggle between our flesh and our spirit. I describe this principle of sin in the flesh as the access the devil has to our flesh. How we break this principle of sin is by seeing ourselves as we truly are in Jesus Christ's redemption. This struggle will be ours until we meet Jesus face to face, but we can say "no" to sin *now* in His power through seeing who we are and *not* who we were prior to Jesus living in us. God has given us a new image of ourselves. We are holy and blameless, the righteousness of God. We are no longer married to Adam's sin. We are married to Christ and His righteousness. It is hard for us to accept this because it does not agree with the way we see ourselves.

As a client trusts his feelings, those feelings will lie to him, giving him condemnation. Then the con-

Then the Word comes into our hearts as the client reads, listens, and studies it. The Word will convict, God will discipline and we become transformed by the renewing of our minds. It is all done by His never condemning or rejecting His child. He loves this child of His. We walk with the client as he struggles to learn to see himself as holy and blameless, above reproach. I call this new identity in Christ the “I” and the old nature the “me”. The “I” is powerful. The “me” died when “I” received Jesus.

With certain clients, they have stuck with me for years and they have walked into this truth I have just shared. I embark on this journey with every believer. If they “stick” with me, they will know this amazing truth, some sooner than later. And the truth sets them free. It is a joy for me to remem-

ber all these blessed clients over the 40-plus years I have counseled.

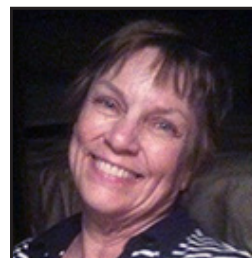
